

Crisis Intervention Plan

The Crisis Intervention Plan will ONLY begin should student cause or be suspected of causing bodily harm to self or others.

All IEP behavior plans will be followed. If the student doesn't have an IEP or the IEP doesn't address a "crisis plan", the following steps will be followed to ensure student safety.

1. Provide visual and/or verbal cue to take a break.
2. Remove students (next door or library)
3. Call office and request Crisis Team
4. Crisis team will assess and may do one of the following:
 - a) Provide quiet space to calm down
 - b) Encourage student to use calming techniques (music, coloring)
 - c) Restraint (ONLY if student is in danger of harming himself/herself or other)
5. If student cannot self-regulate after a reasonable amount of time, student will be sent home for the day.
6. Parent/guardian will be notified of incident via telephone and/or incident report.
7. Student will be kept safe, and monitored at all times.

Note: Based on school policy, should a student run (exit school building), the police will be called.
